Section	Topics
Verbal and Reading Comprehension (VARC)	Verbal Ability, Reading Comprehension, Synonyms Antonyms, English Usage or Grammar, Jumbled Paragraph, Close Passage, Verbal Reasoning, Facts-Inferences-Judgements etc.
Data Interpretation & Logical Reasoning (DILR)	Bar Graphs, Caselets, Column Graphs, Tables, Line Charts, Venn Diagrams, Pie Chart, Combination of two or more types linked to each other, Blood Relations, Calendars, Cubes, Clocks, Number and Letter Series, Binary Logic, Seating Arrangement, Syllogism etc.
Quantitative Ability (QA)	Trigonometry, Algebra, Geometry, Arithmetic, Higher Maths, Mensuration etc.
